Philosophy and Approach

As a professional school counselor working towards my licensed professional counseling license, humanistic theory has been central to my work and informs the techniques I use. Humanists have a holistic approach to counseling and look not just at behaviors but at the whole child.

Humanistic counselors believe that every child wants to get their needs met and be successful. In the context of a school setting, this means meeting students compassionately where they are at, providing support and wrap-around services for them and their families and breaking down barriers that prevent students from reaching their fullest potential.

My work experience is in high needs schools in low socioeconomic neighborhoods, so for me a humanistic counseling approach is critical. It is my job to understand the context of where my students come from and the barriers they have had to overcome in order to help them develop the necessary strategies to be successful in a school setting. I offer a safe environment for students to explore their thoughts, feelings and behaviors without judgment.

Formal Education and Licensure

I am a licensed professional school counselor through the State of Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission which requires that I participate in continuing education. I hold my Masters of Science in School Counseling from Portland State University. My major coursework focused on human development, and supporting children and adolescents' social, emotional and academic needs in school settings while emphasizing the important influence of families. As a professional school counselor I abide by the American School Counseling Association Ethical Standards for School Counselors. In addition, I am also currently registered as an intern with the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists, while I work towards becoming a licensed professional counselor. As an intern, I abide by the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists Code of Ethics and I am supervised by Catherine Nyhan, a Licensed Professional Counselor, which I will be happy to explain in further detail.

Fees

Students enrolled in Clackamas River Elementary School in the Estacada School District who require counseling services will be able to access counseling free of charge.

As a client of an Oregon registered intern, you have the following rights:

- To expect that a licensee has met the qualifications of training and experience required by state law;
- To examine public records maintained by the Board and to have the Board confirm credentials of a licensee;
- To obtain a copy of the Code of Ethics (Oregon Administrative Rules 833-100);
- To report complaints to the Board;
- To be informed of the cost of professional services before receiving the services;
- To be assured of privacy and confidentiality while receiving services as defined by rule or law, with the following exceptions: 1) Reporting suspected child abuse; 2) Reporting imminent danger to you or others; 3) Reporting information required in court proceedings or by your insurance company, or other relevant agencies; 4) Providing information concerning licensee case consultation or supervision; and 5) Defending claims brought by you against me;
- To be free from discrimination because of age, color, culture, disability, ethnicity, national origin, gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, marital status, or socioeconomic status.
